RESOLUTION NO. 2010-07-19 - 13**

**Industrial Pretreatment Permit Renewal – Cost Recovery Enforcement
Policy**

RESOLVED, that this Resolution supplements Resolution 2006-08-21, which addressed certain cost recovery issues.

RESOLVED, that the Easton Area Joint Sewer Authority hereby approves an industrial pretreatment permit renewal policy which provides that an IPP permit holder shall not be entitled to have its permit renewed, and the current IPP permit shall automatically be revoked as of its stated expiration date, unless prior to the expiration date of its current IPP permit, the permit holder has::

- (1) completed all appropriate permit renewal application forms and has supplied to the Pretreatment Coordinator all required information, and
- (2) paid to the Authority all cost recovery fees due the Authority including, without limitation, permit fees, surcharge fees, lab fees, sampling fees, costs, fines and penalties.

Any Permit Holder may appeal the Authority's administrative permit non-renewal decision by filing with the Authority within thirty (30) days after notice permit revocation and non-renewal an appeal of the Authority's action, setting forth the basis for such appeal. The appeal process will then follow the Authority's Resolution No. 2006-08-21 regulations, "Revocation of IPP Permit", paragraph numbers 3 through 8, as applicable.
